


2019 was a year of great opportunity and impact for His Voice Global. The ministry was active in all aspects of our mission statement, as we worked to achieve holistic restoration and raise up leaders among orphans, vulnerable children, widows, and the local church.





## IN UGANDA.

His Voice Global took substantial steps as we began to invest more heavily in our growing group of South Sudanese students and refugees in the area surrounding the city of Arua. We have expanded our on-the-ground presence in Arua so that we now have seven (7) full-time staff members there to provide a Circle of Care for the growing number of college-aged students, primarily graduates from the secondary school in Yei. These students are able to attend trade schools or university because of the Education Fund that has been established and funded by His Voice donors. Another major step involved the huge strides God allowed toward the construction of the Arise Discipleship & Retreat Center just outside of Arua. 2019 saw substantial growth in the funding required to begin the construction of this campus to God's glory in 2020.

## IN KENYA,

the work continues to provide a safe haven for boys and girls impacted by the effects of the sex trade and other unhealthy family environments. Thanks to the work of Rift Valley Hope, in the town of Maai Mahiu, the new boy's rescue center was completed in 2019. In addition to the 26 boys and girls residing in the homes, many of their siblings along with other vulnerable children and women are being given true hope and real assistance through the RVH ministry and staff.





Also, the Lord answered our prayers by opening a flood-gate of opportunities to spread the Gospel and help make reproducing disciples among those we serve in East Africa. In 2019, we were able to train more than 250 people in our Foundation of Hope

curriculum, which teaches pastors as well as new believers to make new disciples with confidence in the Scriptures as they fulfill the Great Commission. In 2019 we were able to lead groups that included pastors, students, and refugees in addition to previously unreached Muslim believers in northwest Uganda.





Fifteen years ago, Amber and I took in our first orphans in South Sudan. I had stopped by a local hospital to pray with people and I had this overwhelming sense that we simply were not doing enough. Yes, I knew what we were doing was important, but it just seemed like it was so small compared to the overall crisis.

As I turned the corner in the hospital I saw this terribly burned boy who was probably about 8 years old. He did not have any family with him at all. Just as I bent down to pray with and just sit next to him, the Holy Spirit said, "One makes up the many."

It was an exquisite picture of learning to love the person right in front of me, all the while trusting that a personal God truly wants to speak restoration and mercy into the lives He puts in my path.

At His Voice Global, this is the exact approach we try to take. We believe God has placed, and will continue to place, the vulnerable in front of us so we can walk alongside them for a lifetime. Our mission is to work in areas of the world with high populations of vulnerable women and children, where we partner with local leaders to fulfill the Great Commission. We currently have partnerships in South Sudan, Kenya, and Uganda.

Uganda is home to over 900,000 child refugees and asylum seekers who have fled conflict or persecution from South Sudan, the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Burundi. Of these, over 71 percent are from South Sudan where years of fighting and economic collapse have relentlessly forced families to abandon their homes.

Most refugee children live with the trauma of having witnessed or suffered forced displacement separation from loved ones, and physical and sexual violence. Even in refuge, many continue to be vulnerable to marginalization and violence, especially gender-based violence.

Over these last fifteen years, we have already been able to see some of "our kids" graduate from secondary school and become young men and women who are now enrolled in technical school or university. It is a fulfilling ministry, and we invite you to join us as we move into a new decade of service.

Our prayer is that you would see how "one makes up the many" can be a lens to empower you in personalizing and acting on behalf of the vulnerable in East Africa through the efforts of His Voice Global and our partners.

### ministry

2020 NEED: \$400,000



His Voice Global will continue to invest in the lives of vulnerable are our seven full-time staff members and their families who live in Arua, Uganda. In addition to their personal support, our Uganda budget provides for two needed vehicles, local ministry operating expenses, along with orphan and vulnerable children care in the near-by Rhino refugee camp.



2020 NEED: \$250,000



A key component of our continued ministry in Uganda is the Arise Discipleship & Retreat Center. His Voice Global will soon begin construction on a place of ministry and discipleship for all who seek to know our great God. Under the direction of His Voice Global's full-time missionaries and in-country support staff, the facility will also be a place for our orphan students and full-time missionaries to call home. The land has been purchased, infrastructure work has been done, and in 2020 we will begin the construction of a campus of buildings from which the Gospel will be spread and new disciples will be trained and sent.

# EDUCATION

2020 NEED: \$200.000

Fifteen years ago, His Voice Global founded an orphan care ministry in South Sudan. When students graduate from the secondary school there, some are ready to continue their education at university or trade schools in neighboring Arua, Uganda. The His Voice Global Education Fund makes it possible

for qualified orphans and vulnerable children from South Sudan or neighboring countries to take this next important life step. While attending school courtesy of our Education Fund scholarships, these students are loved and encouraged by the His Voice staff in Arua as they prepare for life after graduation.



## TRAINING theological & discipleship

2020 NEED: \$75,000




The opportunity to make multiplying disciples for Jesus has never been greater. Therefore, His Voice Global full-time missionaries in the field, with support from our home office, will place an emphasis on theological and discipleship training in response to the ripe fields in Uganda, South Sudan, Kenya, and beyond. Like a pebble being dropped into a pond, we are seeing initial training among church leaders, refugee camp, students, and even those who have never heard the gospel spread like never before. There is a need for expenses related to travel and conducting training classes at least monthly during the year.

## ministry

2020 NEED: \$80,000

In Maai Mahiu, Kenya, many women and children live in unhealthy and dangerous environments. In conjunction with our partners at Rift Valley Hope, His Voice Global supports safe houses and provides a circle of care to lead those we serve to spiritual and physical wholeness and restoration. In addition, this year there will be added focus on economic empowerment to better assist vulnerable women provide a healthy environment for their children.
